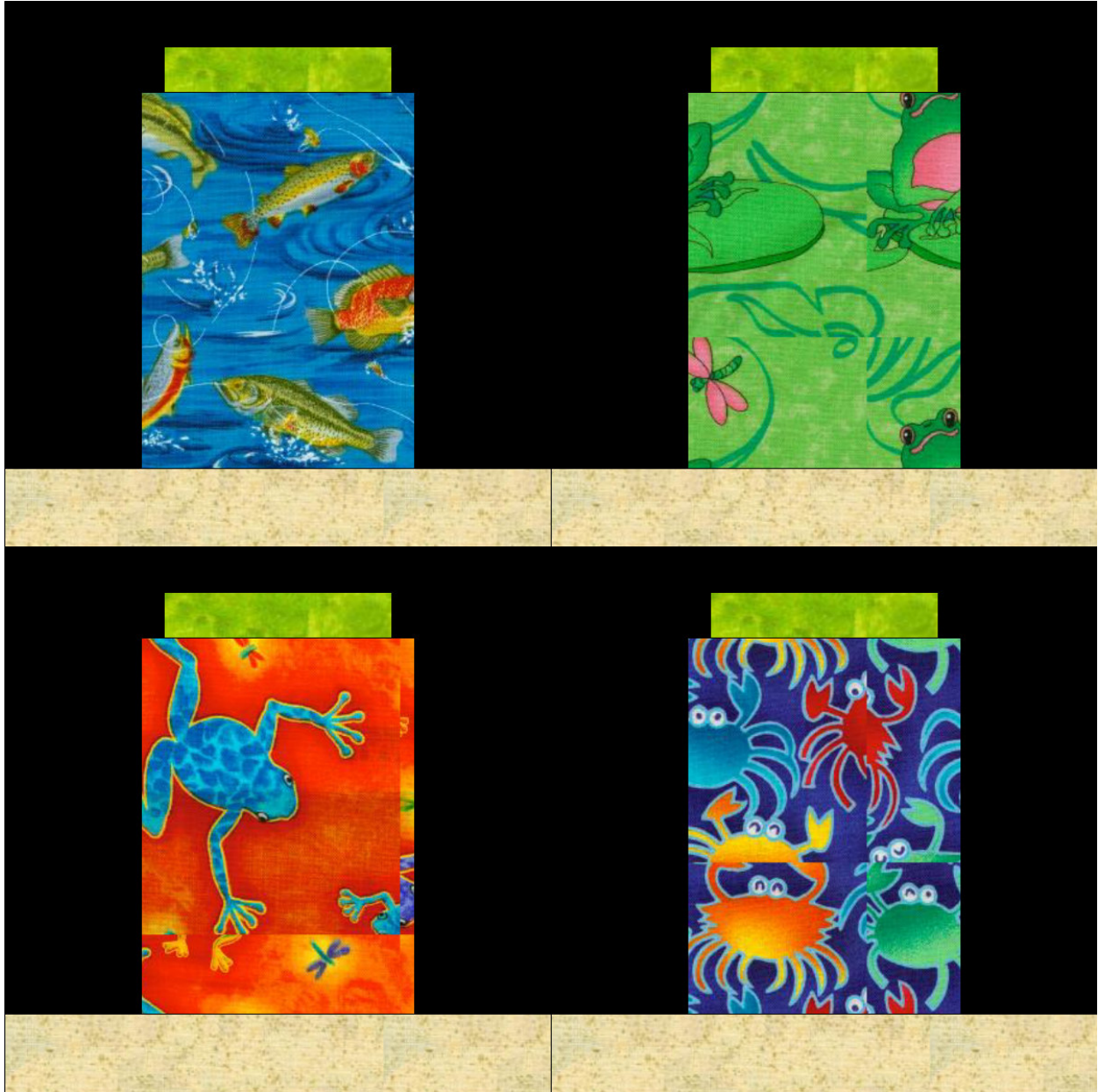


Bugs Jar Quilt

SUPPLY LIST:

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard fabric for background, backing, and sleeve

Use any background you want. Black is pretty effective for many prints and can make the jar seem to pop out from the fabric, but another color might work better with your quilting fabrics.

Thread to match background fabric

5" X 4" fabric for each jar contents: will be doing 4 jars, fill with bugs, fruits, veggies, animals, people or whatever pattern you like!

1" X 3" fabric strip for each jar lid (four lids)

7" X 2" fabric strip for each shelf (four shelves)

Batting (will be supplied by Cathy)

TOOLS, NOTIONS, ETC. NEEDED FOR CLASS

Sewing machine

Basic sewing supplies

PRE CLASS INSTRUCTIONS:

If you want to pre cut your fabrics

Cutting Instructions are for one jar

7 "X 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (1 patch for background)

2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 1" (2 patches for background by lid)

4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (2 patches for background by jar)

7" X $\frac{1}{4}$ " (1 patch for shelf)

4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " X 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1 patch for jar—bugs, candy, etc...)

3" X 1" (1 patch for jar lid)

12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "X 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ "(1 patch for the backing)

We will have a cutting board, rotary cutter, and rulers in the class for you. There are some sewing machines available also.
